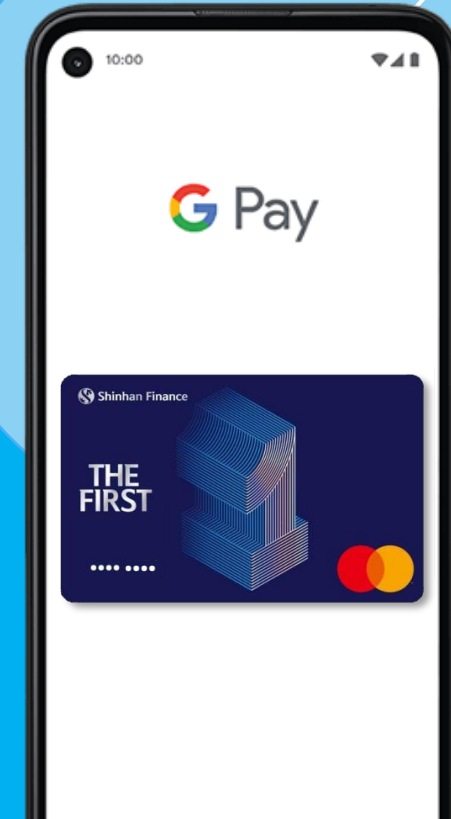


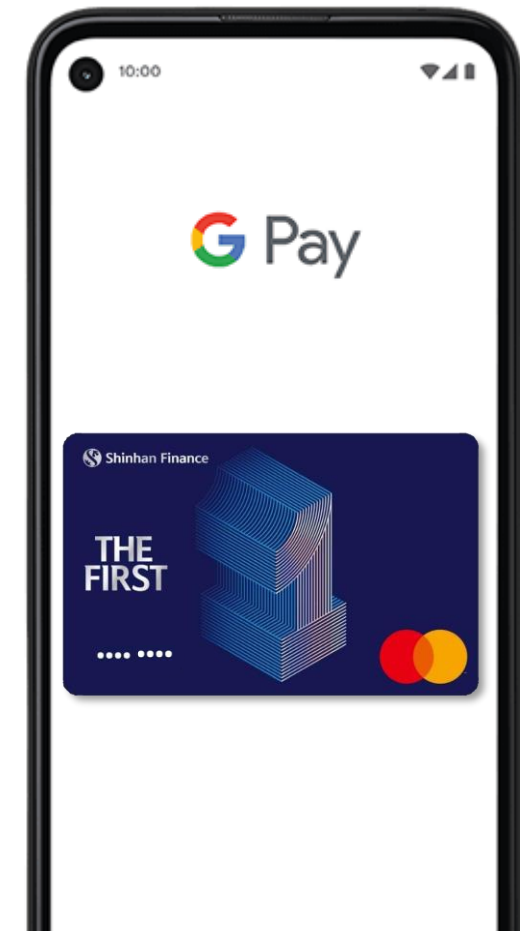

1. Google Pay Introduction

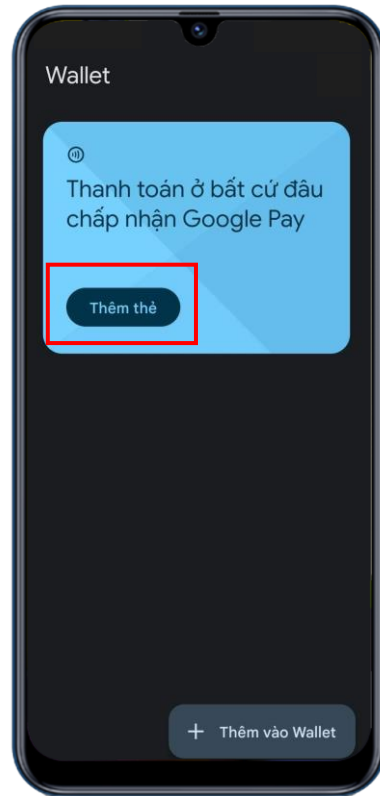
Google Wallet is a payment application on Android operating system that helps users **pay simply, quickly and safely** with card-receiving devices with **contactless technology**. . Cardholders now do not need to carry physical cards or wallets to make payments, Google Wallet makes it easy for you to pay, track transactions on your phone, and keep your cards safe and secure.



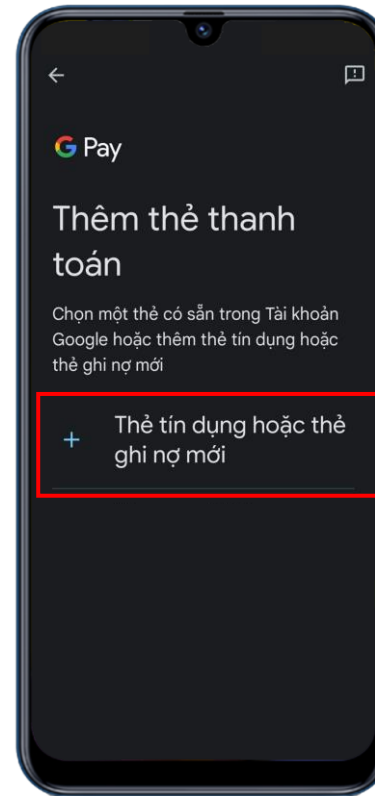
2. How to Use Google Pay



Step 1:
Download **Google Wallet** at Google Play and Launch the app



Step 2:
Choose “Add to Wallet”

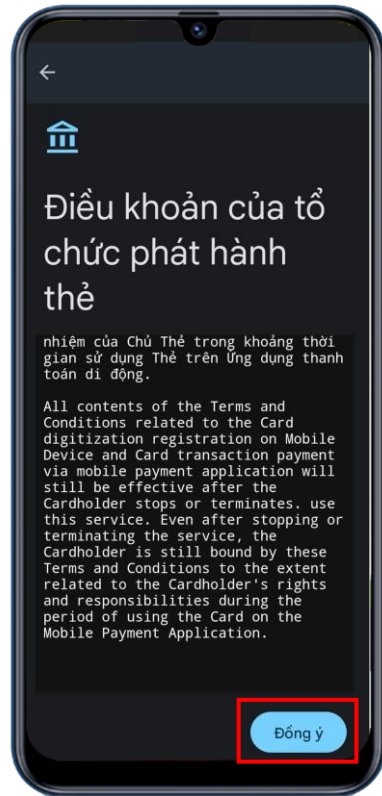


Step 3:
Choose “Credit Card or Debit card”

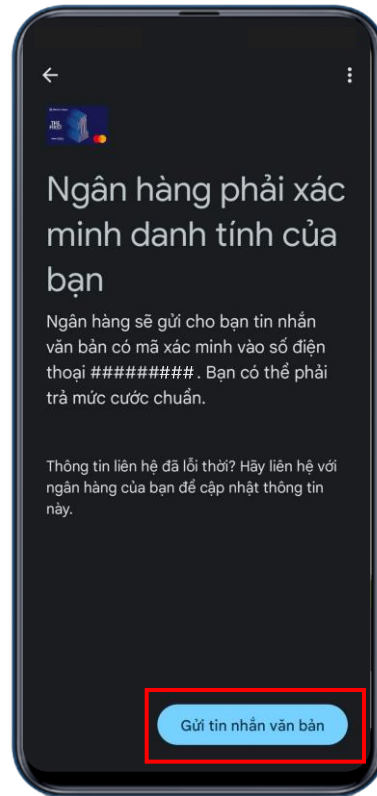


Step 4:

2. How to Use Google Pay



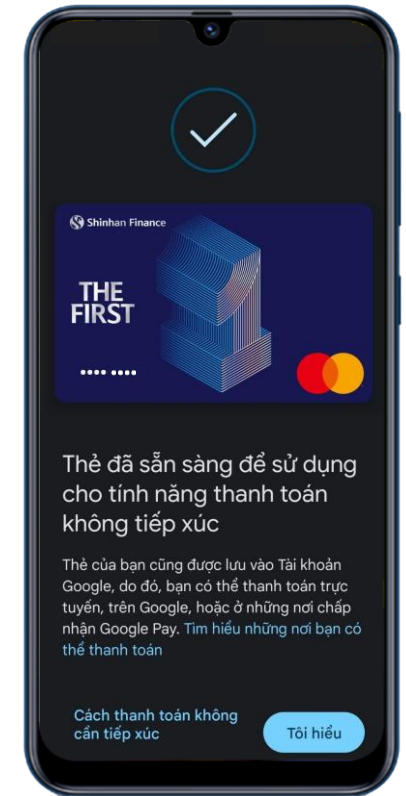
Step 5:
Click on “Agree” once complete reading “The Terms and Condition”

Choose verification method



Step 7:
Input the Verification code

3. Transacting with Google Pay



Cardholders can pay at merchants that accept payments with a contactless POS device or with the Google Pay logo by **launching the Google Wallet app and bringing the mobile device near the screen of the POS device, Hold the phone near the card reader**, a successful transaction notification will appear on the mobile device screen.

Note: You need to Enable NFC (Near-Field Communications) feature on your Android mobile device to make transactions with Google Pay.
